


How to spot fake cosmetics and fragrances?



The packaging differs slightly from the authentic brand (might be a different color or different lettering on the product), and/or the product's wrapping appears haphazard.



The **price** is either slightly or drastically **lower.**

The product is being advertised as a "limited edition", even though the authentic manufacturer doesn't offer it as a limited edition.



For **cosmetics**, the product's **consistency or texture** just doesn't feel or look like the authentic's brand.





For **fragrances**, there's something a little off about the **scent**, and the **color of the fluid** in the bottle might be different from the original.

For both products, they're being sold at **unauthorized retailers**, including flea markets, mail kiosks, and over the internet.
