

What to look for when buying respirators

Check these signs of fakes:



✘ No printed markings at all on the filtering facepiece respirator

✘ No NIOSH marking – or spelled incorrectly

✘ Approval number (TC) missing on filtering facepiece respirator or headband

✘ Filtering facepiece respirator has ear loops instead of headbands

✘ Made of decorative fabric or features decorative add-ons (e.g., sequins)

✘ Claims of approval for children*
